

HOW CAN I HELP??

Help sort the recyclables from the trash

1. Draw a **blue X** on each recyclable item in the garbage can. Remember, only certain items can be **recycled** in MADISON COUNTY.
2. Draw a **green X** on each item in the garbage can that can be **composted** back to nature.
3. Draw a **red X** on each item in the garbage can that cannot be recycled in MADISON COUNTY and must go to the **landfill**.

All the items you colored with the **BLUE X** can go into your **BLUE** recycle bin at home and placed out at the curb on "recycle day" in your neighborhood.

Here is the list of the recyclables that **CAN** be placed in your **blue** bin:

Fiber:

- newspaper
- corrugated cardboard
- mixed office paper
- chipboard - cereal boxes, food boxes
- junk mail
- magazines
- catalogs
- telephone directories
- envelopes
- post-it notes
- school paper

Containers:

- **aluminum cans** - soda cans, beverage cans & aluminum bottles
- **tin or steel cans** (lids removed) - soup or vegetable cans
- **glass bottles** - **green**, amber or **brown**, clear or **white**
- **plastic milk jugs**, plastic orange juice containers (lids removed)
plastic soda bottles, water bottles (lids removed) any plastic bottle with a number **1**, number **2**, number **3**, number **4**, number **5** or number **7** in a triangle (lids removed)
